

WALL BUILDING FACT SHEET

BUILDING FACTS:

A two-story, 37,000 square foot building featuring:

- 14 classrooms
- a state-of-the-art nursing suite containing two simulation labs, a skills room and a hospital reception area
- two science labs (microbiology and anatomy & physiology)
- a Student Success Center offering 20 computer stations, expanded testing space, and four group study rooms containing computers and large-screen TVs
- three student lounges
- upgraded interactive technology, including new projection and videoconferencing systems
- expanded space for community events
- safety and security upgrades

COST:

\$19 million, with funding from the New Jersey State Building our Future Bond Act, Equipment and Leasing Fund, the Higher Education Technology Improvement Fund, Monmouth County, and Brookdale Community College

Brookdale associate degree programs in:

Bachelor's degree programs offered by New Jersey City University, with exclusive transfer and enrollment services for Brookdale students. Programs include:

- an accelerated Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing (BSN)
- RN to BSN
- marketing
- business management
- accounting
- national security studies
- finance
- criminal justice
- fire science

Dual admission is also offered for eligible Brookdale students.

FUTURE INITIATIVES: Brookdale at Wall is currently being considered for Branch Campus status, which would allow for expanded degree programs and a full continuum of education at the site, from high school through a bachelor's degree.

Brookdale at Wall will also serve as home for local early-college high school programs, including the Asbury Park Dream Academy Early College. Dream Academy students will begin studying at Wall in Fall 2018.

BROOKDALE AT WALL STUDENT BODY (2016-17): 573 Brookdale students, 439 New Jersey City University students. Courses also offered for K-12 teachers and local businesses.

PARKING: An addition of 399 new parking spaces, bringing total parking capacity to 599.
