LINCROFT - Six area community leaders, professionals and volunteers will be honored on April 6 during Brookdale Community College's 33rd annual Wilbur Ray Scholarship Dinner at Jacques Reception Center in Middletown.

The event recognizes significant contributions by local residents and organizations that, while substantial, do not always result in public acknowledgement.
